### Teams and Spectators

1. Anyone ill, experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19 or been in contact with a confirmed case of COVID – 19 in the last 14 days should not come to the complex. ### Game Play/Management

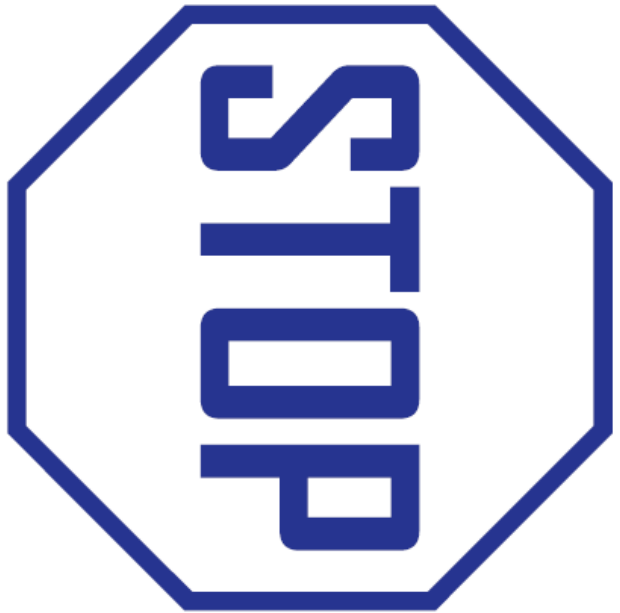
1. To eliminate the exchange between teams; each team will keep their own scorebook or sheet. Verbal run confirmation will occur each ½ inning.

## GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

### **OFFICIALS**

- Teams officiate their own games. A high level of sportsmanship is required. Defense makes out call. Catcher calls strike zone.

### **GAME PLAY**

- Regulation games consist of 7 innings.
- One extra inning may be played if time remains
- No inning may begin 1 hour after the scheduled start time. If a game is completed early, teams may continue to play up until 5 minutes prior to the next scheduled start time. However the score will be recorded as that after the completion of official game.
- A game will be ruled complete if a team is leading by 10 runs after 5 innings, 15 runs after 4 innings and 20 runs after 3 innings.
- Traditional Baseball/Softball rules apply unless specified.

### **PITCHING**

- No bouncies. The strike zone is 1 foot to either side of home plate or no more than 1 foot above the ground at home plate.
- The pitcher must stay behind or in contact with the pitching rubber until the ball is kicked.
  - No fielder may advance past the 1<sup>st</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> base diagonal until the ball is kicked.
- The catcher must remain behind the kicker until the ball is kicked.

### **KICKING**

- All kicks must be made by foot or lower leg
- All kicks must occur with the plant foot even with or behind the front of home plate.
- Each team is allowed one bunt per inning. Additional bunts will be ruled as a foul ball. A bunt is a ball that is intentionally tapped into fair play.

### **BASE RUNNING**

- No base stealing or leading off.
- Hitting a runner above the shoulder is not allowed. A base runner hit above the shoulders is safe and advances one base. A runner intentionally using their head to block the ball or hit while attempting to "duck" a throw is out.
- A runner is granted 1 base beyond the one they were running to at the time of the overthrow going out of play.
- Courtesy runners (last out) are allowed for injured players with opposition's approval. Ghost runners are not allowed.

### **OUTS**

- A total of 3 missed kicks, foul balls or balls thru the strike zone in any combination.
- A kicked ball foul or fair that is caught before it hits the ground.
- A runner touched by the ball at any time while not on base.
- A runner off of the base when the ball is kicked.
